

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

WORLD PREMIERE: 1 March 2025 at Skånes Dansteater, Malmö.

TOURING: September - October 2025.

DURATION: **Approx. 70 minutes, no interval.**AGE RECOMMENDATIONS: **12 years and up.**

VENUE REQUIREMENTS: Dressing room, shower and toilet.

WARM-UP: Rehearsal or dance studio for joint warm-up, approximately 3 x 4 m (12 m²).

LAUNDRY REQUIREMENTS: Washing & drying.

OPTIMAL STAGE DIMENSIONS: (width) 10 m x (depth) 7 m x (height) 6 m. Minimum playing area required is (width) 8 m x (depth) 6 m.

SET UP: 8 hours for technical work and spacing before the performance. 3 hours post performance.

SET-UP CREW: 4 people, at least 1 of them with good knowledge of venue and technical equipment.

SKÅNES DANSTEATER STAFF: 10 people (4 dancers, 1 rehearsal director, 4 technicians, 1 driver)

ABOUT LUDVIG DAAE

Ludvig Daae is a choreographer and dancer based in Stockholm and Oslo. In 2017 he choreographed Cullberg at the Nobel Banquet in the Blue Hall in Stockholm, and since then he has been commissioned by KHiO, the Royal Swedish Ballet School and Norrdans. He is currently working on three new projects: Meningen med livet (The Meaning of Life), an interactive caravan park, which is a collaboration with Tove Berglund. Perfect Lover, a duet collaboration with dance artist Marcus Baldemar that explores platonic love between two gay men, seen through the filter of their joint training in postmodern dance. His latest performance, Spiti: The House of Us, explores building, creating and moving home.

He has a long-term collaboration with filmmaker Joanna Nordahl and their latest performance The Viral Dance toured with Dansnät Sweden autumn 2020 and Dansnät Norway spring 2023.

As a dancer, he has collaborated with Deborah Hay (USA), Mårten Spångberg (SE), Compagnie Thor (BE) and Ingun Bjørnsgaard (NO), among others. His own performances have been presented in 14 countries at venues such as Den Norske Opera og Ballett (NO), Spielart Festival (DE), The Place (UK), Vooruit (BE), Sophiensaele (DE), Dansens Hus (SE), Gessnerallee (CH), Moderna Museet (SE), Biennale de danse de Val du Marne (FR), MDT (SE), Mousonturm (DE) and GUldance (PT).

In December 2015, Ludvig celebrated 100 performances in 10 countries of his solo show MM at Sophiensæle in Berlin. MM has been selected as the only Nordic contribution to the international dance network Aerowaves, made the top 10 list of best performing arts in 2014 in Portugal and earned Ludvig the title of "one of the young hopes for European dance" by the German dance magazine Tanz. In 2014, the solo toured Norway with Riksteateret, and Sweden with Dansnät Sverige.
